

## **NOMINATION GUIDELINES FOR THE 2024 AGS ECR AND MCR AWARD**

A. **Formatting:** Single PDF. A4 paper setting, line spacing as per below, Arial font (11 point).

**Please note that any nomination failing to comply with these application guidelines (e.g. deadline, requested information, formatting requirements, space limits,...) will NOT be taken into consideration.**

B. **Nomination details:** The **Proposer** should submit the Nomination on behalf of the **Nominee** by sending a single PDF document directly to AGS President Morten Andersen ([morten.andersen@mq.edu.au](mailto:morten.andersen@mq.edu.au), chair of the AGS Award Committee) before December 20, 2023, 5 pm (Sydney time). The nomination must contain the below details as numbered in the following order, and must **not exceed the maximum space limits**.

1. **Proposer** (name, title, affiliation, email, phone, address)
2. **Referee** (name, title, affiliation email, phone, address)
3. **Nominee** (name, title, affiliation, email, phone, address, relationship to Proposer and Referee)
4. **Nominee's educational qualifications** (clearly indicate the date of PhD conferral)
5. **Nominee's previous appointments and current position** (including their time post-PhD and clear description/justification of career disruptions factored into the post-PhD time)
6. **Nominee's previous honours and awards**
7. **Nominee's career achievements, contributions, impact and potential** (double line spacing)

Succinct description of the nominee's:

- a. Scientific achievements and contributions to building teams and capabilities, mentoring and outreach, the significance of these contributions, and an explanation as to why the nominee is especially qualified to receive the award [max. 2 page] [40%].
- b. Contributions to the glycoscience community including the AGS [max. 1 page] (10%).
- c. Growing inter/national standing in field [max. 1 page] (30%).
- d. Potential for impact as a future research leader in glycoscience [max. 1 page] (20%)

### **8. Nominee's publications** (single line spacing)

This list should not include abstracts, and should be in two parts.

(i) The five best publications from the last five years, plus up to five other papers across the entire career, with a brief annotation for each paper (no more than 3 lines) describing its significance. Numbers of citations (indicate source e.g. Google Scholar), and the impact factor of the journal and the ranking of that journal within its field must be given for these 10 publications (source this data from Journal Citation Report, Clarivate).

(ii) A full list of publications OR a link to publications (e.g. PubMed, ORCID..). Do not include manuscripts not yet accepted for publication.

### **9. Any other evidence that may help your case** [max. 1 page] (e.g. industrial collaborations that could not be published, demonstration of impact beyond classic research metrics,...)
